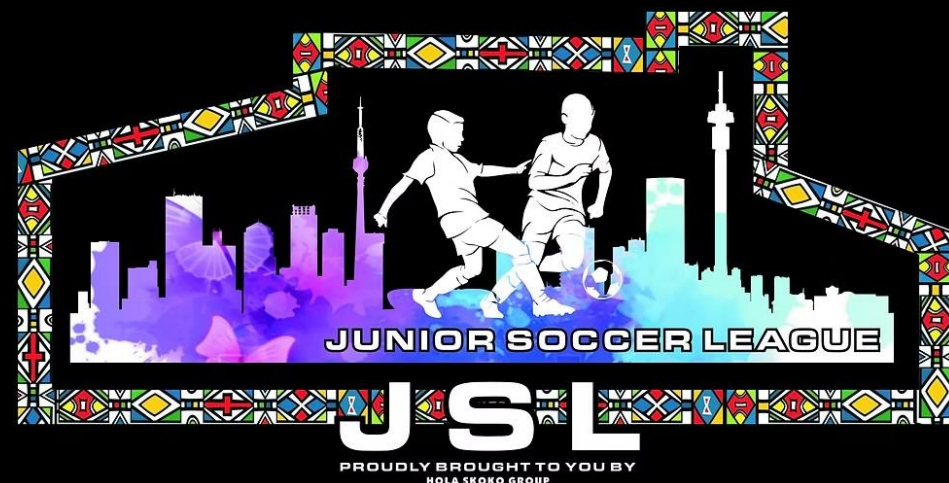
The second edition of the Junior Soccer League promises to be an exciting and memorable experience for everyone involved, as it continues to grow in both scale and significance within the local soccer community.

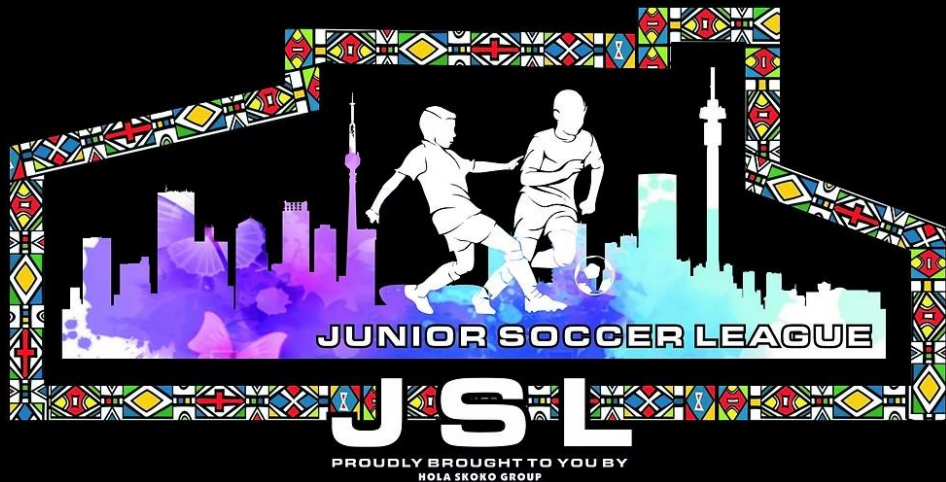

RULES AND REGULATIONS



RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Under 6/7 kick ins and not throw ins
- Under 8-14 throw ins
- No goals may be scored directly from an indirect free kick or a kick in.
- No persons allowed to stand behind the goal
- Kick-off – opponents to be 4.5m away
- Free Kick - opponents to be 6m away
- Penalty - 6m from goal line
- No offsides
- There will be no postponement of any match. However, should a team have a valid reason to reschedule, match may be brought forward on a convenient time for both teams
- Under 6/7 on field coaching allowed – only 1 coach
- Under 8-14 no on field coaching allowed
- Absolutely no fighting, swearing or violence will be tolerated. If teams are caught (with evidence) they will be removed from the league immediately.

CODE OF CONDUCT



CODE OF CONDUCT

- At Hola Skoko we require that all our employees/volunteers conduct themselves according to the highest standards of ethics, integrity, and behaviour when dealing with stakeholders including players, match officials, parents, spectators, coaches, team managers and academy officials. To deliver the principals of sportsmanship and fair play and to promote mutual respect among players, coaches, referees, and spectators. The Code is intended to provide behavioural guidance and establish clear expectations for all involved. Where these standards are not met, appropriate action will be taken. Coaches will be positive role models.



STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

- Coaches will display and instil in their players the principals of good sportsmanship and team play
- Promote high standards of behaviour at all times
- Punctuality – ensure that you are always punctual for meetings/training/games
- Consistent effective communication always
- Never engage in offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour towards players, match officials, parents, spectators, coaches, team managers and academy officials.
- Avoid bullying, intimidation and poor behaviour towards fellow members and players, match officials, parents, spectators, coaches, team managers, and academy officials
- Never discriminate against any fellow member and player, match official, parent, spectator, coach, team manager, or club official regardless of age, ethnicity, gender, or race.
- As a professional football academy, we must be honest, respectful, and truthful towards fellow members and players, match officials, parents, spectators, coaches, team managers, and academy officials.



STANDARDS OF CONDUCT

- Coaches will conduct themselves in a manner that best serves the interests of the players.
- Coaches will do their best to provide the players a positive & fun experience.
- Coaches will ensure that winning and/or losing teams do so in a manner, which exhibits respect and good sportsmanship.
- Coaches will treat all players, parents, spectators, opposing coaches, league officials and referees with respect.
- Any Physical contact in an aggressive manner, Profanity, Verbal abuse, Obscene gestures will not be tolerated.
- Coaches will provide instruction in a manner that is constructive and supportive.
- Coaches will not ridicule or demean players, other coaches, or referees.
- Under NO Circumstances will a coach yell or storm the field at a referee.
- Coaches will not tolerate behaviour that endangers the health or wellbeing of a child.
- Coaches will comply with the decisions of league officials and observe all rules, policy and procedure as established.
- Coaches will teach the game of football to the best of their ability.
- Coaches will be drug and alcohol free while at any Hola Skoko event
- Coaches will not use any tobacco products/e-cigarettes/vapes of any nature on the playing field/training ground.
